

The Zon Mark 4 Propane Cannon provides a single pressure regulated sonic blast to frighten and disorient pest birds & wildlife.



The Zon Mark 4 Propane Cannon provides a single pressure regulated sonic blast to frighten and disorient pest birds & wildlife.

After setting the regulator at the desired blast interval (from 40 seconds to 30 minutes) the Zon will operate unattended. Blasts are generated by readily available propane gas. A standard 20 pound tank will provide approximately 17,000 detonations. The volume of the blast is adjustable from 100 - 125 decibels.

The Tripod Assembly elevates the Zon ~4' high and allows it to rotate approximately 60° with the impact of each blast. This

protects more acreage since each blast is in a different direction from the last.

> For taller crops, Trip od Extension Kits can be added to

raise the cannon as much as 4 additional feet.

The Zon Automatic ■ Timer allows you to

set a daily on/off time, so the cannon will run unattended until the propane tank needs refilling.

The Zon Mark 3 Electronic Propane Cannon enhances the features of the Zon Mark 4 with an electronic control module that allows for

multi-blast operation (up to 3 blasts per cycle), and

random firing patterns. The Zon Mark 3 has a built-in on/off timer, which allows the cannon to be

programmed to fire only when needed.

Electronic Zon multi-blast options:

- •Single (blast interval is set with separate control)
- Double or Triple (under 10 second interval between blasts)

Electronic Zon random firing options:

 Short Interval – blast(s) will fire unpredictably between 1 and 4.5 minutes apart.

The Zon Mk. 3 requires a 12 volt batter, and a 20 lb. propane tank (sold separately).

•Medium Interval - blast(s) will detonate unpredictably between 2 and 9 minutes apart. RENTAL PROGRAM

- Long Interval blast(s) will detonate unpredictably
- between 3 and 13.5 minutes

CANNON REPAIR SERVICE

We offer an economical propane cannon repair service for Zons Mark 2, 3, and 4. The average repair job ranges from ~\$50 - ~\$125 per cannon (includes parts and labor), depending on condition of cannon. A standard repair job includes: diagnosis of malfunction, replacement parts as needed, pressure test of regulators, lubrication of wear and rub points, alignment of the tripping mechanism, and a test firing of the cannon to ensure proper blast interval and operation.
